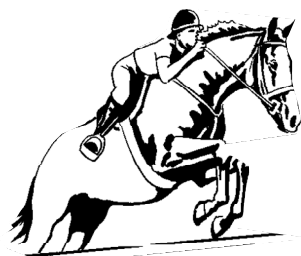

- Negative Coggins is required - there are NO exceptions.
- Judging based on USEF & SSBC rules. Judge's decisions are final.
- All stallions must be handled by an adult (18 or older).
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs allowed on SSBC grounds.
- All riders must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" release form.

- SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property.
- Appropriate Dress, Boots & ASTM Helmets must be worn by all contestants.
- All dogs must be on a leash.
- For the safety of our riders, classes may be divided if number of entries warrants.

All Equestrians under 18 must wear an ASTM approved helmet, securely fastened, while mounted or otherwise handling a horse, on any part of the Silver Sands property.
